

A tour of Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream Factory fills you in on the process of making ice cream and ends with a sample of their world-famous scoops. Or, take an optional tour of the Trapp Family Lodge\*, where you'll learn the fascinating history of this local treasure before heading to the von Trapp brewery for a traditional beer flight tasting followed by dinner. Day 5: Thursday, October 14, 2021 Stowe - North Conway, New Hampshire Today we are New Hampshire bound! Soak in the lovely New England countryside as you journey through the White Mountains of New Hampshire. Make a stop to explore the Rocks Estate, home to the North Country Conservation & Education Center. On a tour of the farm, learn about the history and importance of maple sugaring in the region and visit a virtual tap room. Later, continue to North Conway via the Kancamagus Highway, a scenic byway offering spectacular views of the White Mountains region. (*B*, *D*)

Day 6: Friday, October 15, 2021 North Conway - Lake Winnipesaukee - Coastal Maine Journey to New Hampshire's picturesque lakes region, a popular vacation spot for visitors yearround. Board the M/S Mount Washington and spend the next hour cruising stunning Lake Winnipesaukee, New Hampshire's largest lake. Then, visit the charming town of Wolfeboro, the "oldest summer resort in America." Later, head for the picturesque coast of Maine for a relaxing two night stay. (B)

Day 7: Saturday, October 16, 2021 Coastal Maine Maine's iconic coastline is best experienced from the sea. On a scenic cruise, take in spectacular views of the rocky shore, populated with lighthouses and summer homes. Be on the lookout for harbor seals and other wildlife, and learn about the importance of the ocean to the local economy. Enjoy time at leisure to explore Maine's quintessential seaside towns. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a very special farewell dinner featuring fresh native lobster, for which coastal Maine is renowned. (*B, D*)

Travel within USA

Effective for travel October 1, 2021 forward, the REAL ID Act standards for identification while travelling will be in effect. This means a standard issued driver's license used as a form of identification will no longer be accepted for domestic air travel within the United States. Instead, a Real ID compliant form of identification must be presented both at the time of booking air travel with Collette and upon checking in at the airport to board any flight. Any fees associated with changing a reservation resulting from a non-compliant identification will be the responsibility of the guest. #### Experience It! Cruise Lake Winnipesaukee

A visit to New Hampshire is not complete without a sail on Lake Winnipesaukee aboard the famous motorship M/S *Mount Washington*. Since 1872, only two vessels have been named Mount Washington. The original was built for moving travelers and cargo from one side of the big lake to the other by the Boston & Maine Railroad Company. Today the "Mount" provides the best opportunity to enjoy the scenic beauty of the region, from the White Mountains to luxurious lakefront homes, and ports like Weirs Beach, Wolfeboro and Meredith. With its wide, spacious decks, there is ample room on this 1,250-passenger vessel to move about as a local expert calls out stunning views, points of interest, and local lore.
